Suitable for Reception - Year 2

This is an idea that can be adapted to suit your class or setting and can be lengthened or shortened to meet your children's needs.

The players

7 short speaking parts:

King George

Queen Elizabeth (the Queen Mother)

Doctor

Nanny

Princess Elizabeth

Princess Margaret

Prince Phillip

A group of boys to be guards at the palace gate.

A group of girls to attend the princesses' birthday party, each with a hobby horse (made by the children?)

A group of children to be African animals

Scenery

The children could make their own scenery or actual photographs could be projected as a backdrop.

Scene 1- Outside Buckingham palace

King George and Queen Elizabeth

Guards march onto the stage and stand in 2 lines facing each other outside the palace.

They sing with help from whole cast-

We're the guards at the palace gate,

Keeping watch at our posts night and day,

We're the guards, standing tall and straight and the people must do as we say!

When a stranger comes that we do not know, (Doctor arrives)

You will hear our voices sing!

Halt! Who goes there?

Are you friend or foe?

(Doctor says 'Friend') (Guards beckon him in)

Then pass in the name of the King!

Princess Elizabeth and Princess Margaret (holding hobby horses)

Margaret's my sister,

It's her birthday today,

(Margaret) 'I call her Lillibet,

It's easier to say!

Doctor

I am the doctor,

The queen's not sick!

She's having a baby,

I hope it will be quick!

Group of girls dressed in party dresses and Princess Elizabeth and Princess Margaret each with a hobby horse.

*We're having a party,
It's so much fun,
We're going to play 'Horsey, Horsey'
It's our favourite one.*

Children dance in a ring with their hobby horses, singing with help from the cast

*Horse, Horse,
Don't you stop,
Just let your feet go clippity clop,
Your tail goes swish as the wheels go round
'Giddy up! We're homeward bound!'*

*I am Prince Phillip
I've come to see the king
To ask to marry Elizabeth
I've got her a ring*
