

Listening Cards



Friday 18 March

Use this activity to help develop children's listening, attention and understanding. Give each child a card with keywords from Jinnat's poem and ask them to hold up their card when they hear the word. At the end of the activity, they can use the cards to help them retell Jinnat's story.

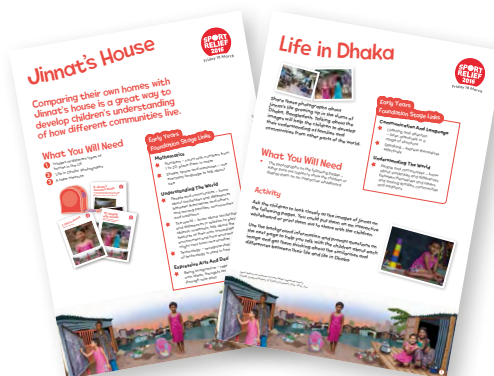
What you will need

- 1 The poster 'Jinnat's Story'
- 2 Printouts of the cards at the end of this activity (one for each child)



Activity

- Give each child a card and make sure they understand the word or words on their card. (Some children may have the same card, which is fine.) Ask children to hold up their card when they hear the words in the poem.
- After the poem is finished, ask the children to place the cards in the order that they heard them in the poem and retell the story.
