

Make an Easter Garden

Making an Easter garden is a lovely thing to do in Holy Week in preparation for Easter. You can make a small one for indoors or a bigger one for your garden or balcony.

You will need

- A seed tray / a large dish / large plant container or a space in your garden surrounded by a border maybe of twigs or pebble.
- A flowerpot or some big pebbles to make a tomb.
- One large pebble or rock for the front of the tomb.
- Some moss or turf.
- Compost (best for an inside garden) or garden soil
- Some small growing flowers or some cut flowers in a small container of water.
- Some twigs and a glue gun for making 3 crosses. If you don't have a glue gun you can fix the sticks together with wire or string – search for 'square lashing knot' on youtube to see an example of how to do this.

You can make the garden in advance and add the crosses and the stone in front of the tomb on Good Friday.

Move the stone away on Easter Day.

Keep the grass/ moss damp by spraying with water and make sure the flowers have enough water.
